About the project

The City of Stonnington is upgrading the indoor change rooms at Harold Holt Swim Centre, to deliver contemporary change rooms that support our commitment to building and maintaining quality community facilities.

To upgrade the current change rooms, that have come to the end of their useful life, all change room fittings will be removed and a full refit completed.

The works will be completed in stages to maintain the operation of the sauna and spa for as long as practical.

We recognise works of this nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.



Works

- » Demolish existing flooring, joinery, fixtures, lighting and toilets
- » Remove material from site
- » Install new joinery, flooring, finishes, lighting, fixtures and toilets
- » Reinstatement as required

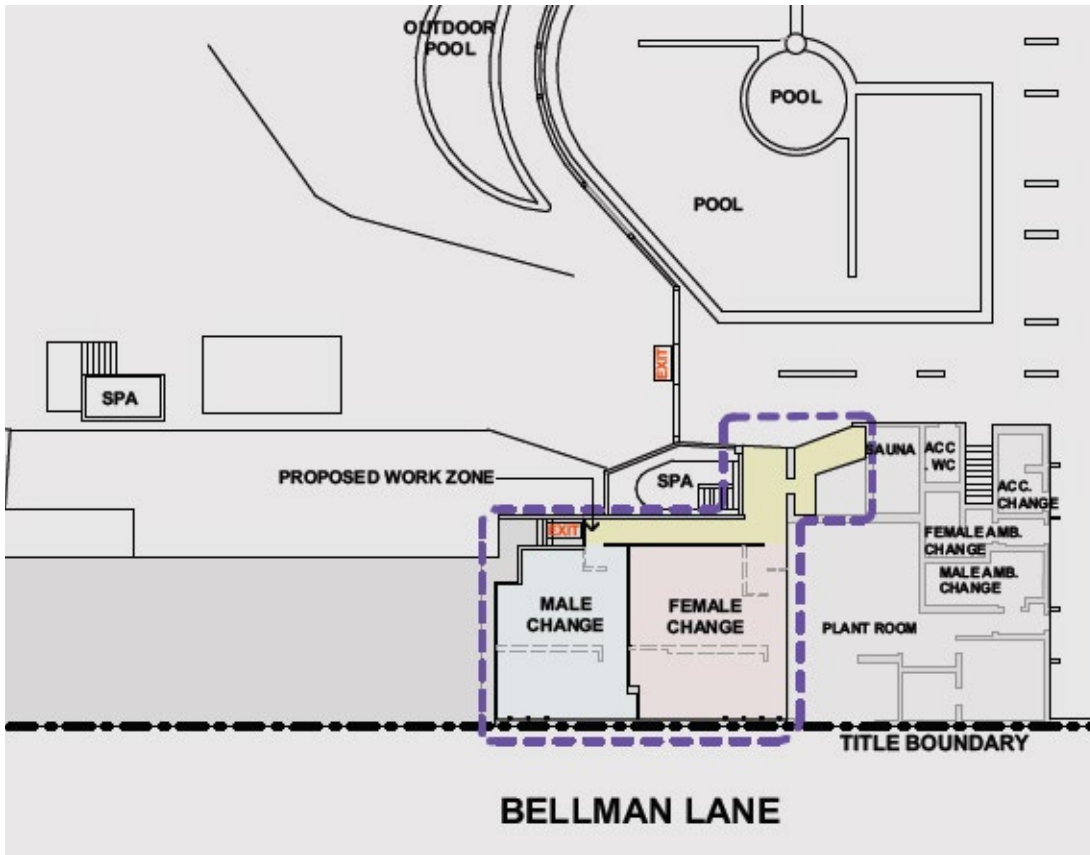
