



Streetscape Improvement Works

Stage 2A – Orrong Road from Robertson Street to Struan Street, Toorak: 16 June to mid-August 2021 (approximately eight weeks)

About the project

The City of Stonnington is upgrading Orrong Road between Toorak Road and St Georges Road, Toorak. This is Stage 2 of the Orrong Road improvement program. Stage 1 (drainage reconstruction works) was completed in 2020.

The project will be completed across five stages, with the final stage expected to be completed by December 2021.

We recognise works of this nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.



- » Restore bluestone kerbs
- » Rejuvenate nature strips (including grass seeding where needed)
- » Reconstruct 4x roundabouts
- » Upgrade footpaths
- » Resurface road

Roadworks and COVID-19

Under Victorian Government COVID-19 guidelines, civil construction projects are 'permitted works'. The works must follow a strict High Risk COVID-Safe plan. As the works are in the open air no other requirements are applied.
