CONSTRUCTION UPDATE 12

July 2023

Recap on works to date

It's full steam ahead at Percy Treyvaud Memorial Park's new multipurpose sport and recreation facility. As we reach the mid-year mark, our team is making great progress and remains on schedule. Last month, we completed the timber flooring on the netball and basketball courts, and we have almost finished installing the bowling green canopy. The temporary carpark on Chadstone Road has also reopened. This will ease congestion along neighbouring streets. In June, we worked more than 18,000 hours, bringing our total hours worked since January 2022 to 135,000.

What to expect in the month ahead

Rob Roy Road footpath closure

Later in July, we will temporarily close the Rob Roy path to install four park benches, new lighting, rubbish and recycling bins, and connect the footpaths to the sport and recreation facility.

Playground

We will also be refreshing the facilities near the children's outdoor play area. Perfect for all the family, this installation will include three park benches and tables, drinking fountains, bicycle racks, a community barbeque, and new pathways to access the area.

Outdoor sports fields

This month we will begin the synthetic surfacing of the bowling green and tennis courts.

Pavilion

Just in time for the wet start to winter, the pavilion is now water-tight and our work on the building's interior is taking shape. We have started on the ground floor bathrooms and are also finishing the indoor sports courts, including the line markings.
