The City of Stonnington is improving the lighting in Brookville Gardens and Fairbairn Reserve to improve safety for people visiting the park in the evening.

We are also making some park improvements in Brookville Gardens by installing new park furniture, upgrading the paving and updating the Canterbury Road fencing.

This is the second and final stage of the Brookville Gardens/Fairbairn Reserve improvement works.

- » More and better park and path lighting
- » New park furniture (picnic settings and new seat)
- » Upgrade paving on top of mound and barbecue area
- » Update Canterbury Road fence

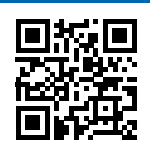
