CUMMINS GROVE, MALVERN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION



16 August 2021

The City of Stonnington's Engineering Projects unit wishes to update residents on the ongoing road reconstruction at Cummins Grove, Malvern. Major Road work has now been completed. **Resident are advised that they can now park their vehicles within Cummins Grove as from today 16 August 2021.** The City of Stonnington wishes to thank all residents for their cooperation and understanding during the road works.

Cleaning and other minor works will be completed by 18 August 2021. Waste collection will return to normal. Residents are advised to revert back to the waste collection routine for Cummins Grove prior to the start of the reconstruction works.

The reconstruction of Cummins Grove is a part of Council's ongoing commitment to providing residents with a safe and functional road and drainage network. The main construction work incorporated the following components:

- The road pavement was fully resurfaced with asphalt.
- The existing kerb and channel were reconstructed.
- The existing footpath and vehicle crossings were reconstructed in concrete.
- The laneway section aligning with Cummins Grove (only) was reconstructed.

The contractor CDN Constructors Pty Ltd and the City Of Stonnington Council will remain on standby to attend to any resident complaints relating to the road works. Working hours are 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

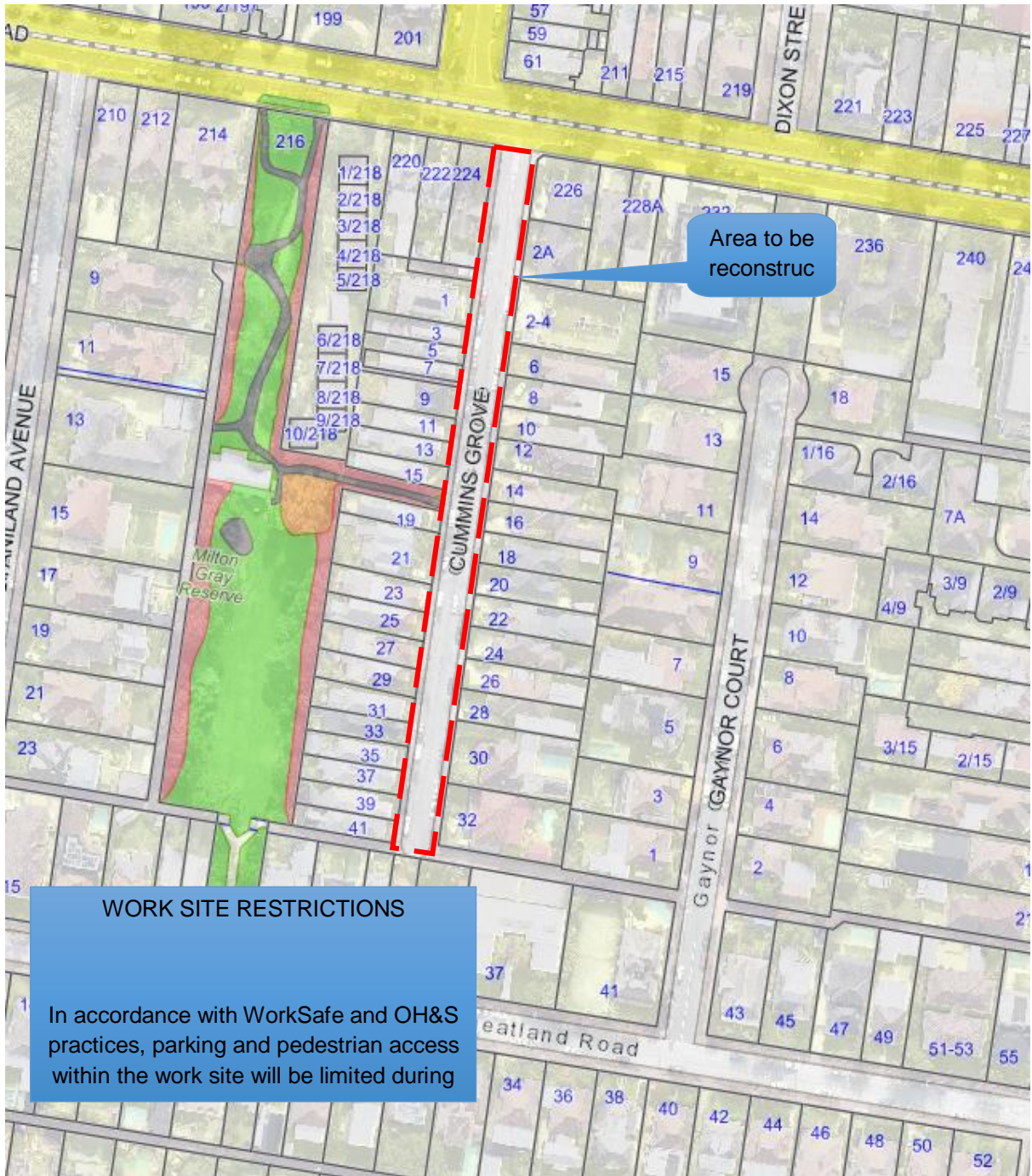
Q. Will "Pedestrian Access" be affected?
