ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

The City of Stonnington's Engineering Department wishes to advise residents and other organisations that the reconstruction of Thomas Street South, Windsor is scheduled to commence on **Monday 20 September 2021**.

The works will be undertaken by Panhold Constructions Pty Ltd and will include:

- New underground drainage
- New footpath
- New kerb & channel
- New charcoal coloured concrete vehicle crossings
- Asphalt resurfacing of the road
- Associated reinstatement works

Working hours are **7am to 5pm** Monday to Friday and **8am to 5pm** on Saturday.

The contractor Panhold Constructions and the City Of Stonnington Council will endeavour to minimise disruption at all times. However, some inconveniences are unavoidable during the construction period. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during these works.

Q. Will "Pedestrian Access" be affected?

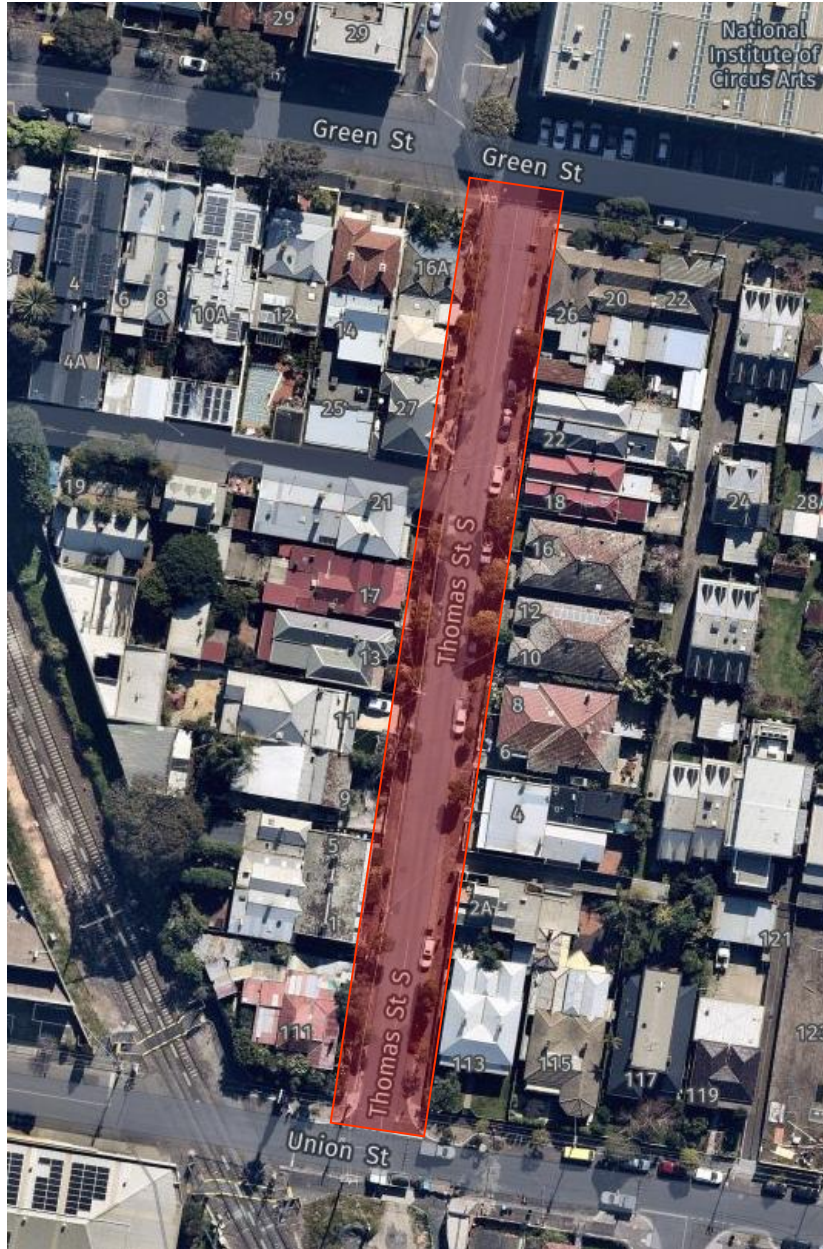
