The City of Stonnington is creating a new pocket park at the northern end of Vista Grove in Toorak.

These works will see the existing grassed area at the cul-de-sac end of Vista Grove expanded with more greenery, new seating, garden beds, a paved viewing area, a new footpath connection and feature planting. All existing trees will be retained.
