RAISED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING CONSTRUCTION - YARRA STREET, SOUTH YARRA

The City of Stonnington is constructing a new raised pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Yarra Street and Toorak Road in South Yarra. This crossing will maintain the temporary treatment trialled by the Department of Transport where traffic can only exit left out of Yarra Street onto Toorak Road and there is no vehicle access to Yarra Street from Toorak Road.

The works involve construction of a new raised pedestrian crossing replacing the current temporary crossing, adjoining footpath, installation of flashing lights, signage and linemarking. Works will be undertaken in stages so that pedestrian access is maintained in this busy area.

We recognise that works of this nature will cause some inconvenience. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum and we thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

Works

- New raised pedestrian crossing replacing the current temporary crossing.
- Adjoining footpath works.
- Installation of flashing lights.
- Signage.
- Line marking.

Residents

During working hours between 7am and 5pm, there will be noise, dust and construction vehicle movements associated with the works. Access to properties will be maintained.

Pedestrians

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, with measures in place to direct pedestrians safely around the works zone.

Cyclists

The bike lane on Toorak Road will be kept open for the majority of construction, however at times the bike lane will be closed, and cyclists will be required to dismount and walk their bikes.

Public transport

Tram operations and the South Yarra Station tram stop will be unaffected by these works. Access to South Yarra Station will be maintained.

Parking

Three parking spaces on Yarra Street closest to the intersection will be closed for the duration of the works for construction plant and materials and permanently upon completion to accommodate the redesigned crossing.

Motorists

During construction, the intersection of Yarra Street and Toorak Road will be closed. Traffic will be diverted to Claremont Street via the laneway, or southbound on Yarra Street, to exit at Alexandra Avenue. Motorists should seek alternative routes where available. Traffic diversions and traffic management measures will be in place to ensure the safety of road users and pedestrians.
